Whilst there was no doubt that there were complexities and additional dimensions to the implementation of GDPR, it nonetheless had to be seen as a positive step and be an integral part of the company's culture and modus operandi going forward.



We therefore decided to leverage what was (and still is) a very significant and important body of legislation into ways of doing things better and more efficiently for the future - by tightening up on existing processes, adding new ones, and creating a coherent overall approach to a topic that has the potential to affect all of us, whether collectively, professionally or personally.

This booklet seeks to give an overview of GDPR, what it is and what we're doing about it, and also indicate sources of more detailed information such as our Company Policy, Privacy Policy and contact details of the regulatory body, the ICO.

We must therefore make it our ongoing duty of care to ensure that we treat it with the respect it deserves at all times, in accordance with the law. What is GDPR?

GDPR is the General Data Protection Regulation legislation that is in force from the 25th May 2018.

Put simply, the GDPR legislation concerns the security and correct use of data (in whatever form/s held) by and within an organisation. It effectively supersedes previous legislation surrounding data protection and related topics.

This flagship legislation will be monitored by an oversight regulatory body. Simple though that may sound, the legislation is wide ranging and complex, with ramifications across all departments within the company – whether Sales, Service, Parts, Human Resources, Payroll, Marketing, Accounts/Finance and so on.

Why Does GDPR Matter?

Implementation of GDPR is important to the Platinum Group because it is a legal requirement.

This legislation is regulated by the ICO (Information Commissioner's Office), who have the right to conduct thorough and detailed investigations if a complaint is received. Should a company be found to be in breach of the regulations, the regulator has the power to impose significant fines if it sees the need to do so.

It is, of course, our duty of care to ensure the secure keeping and correct use of all data that our team members and customers have entrusted us with.



What Have We Done About It?

In order to implement GDPR at the point of the legislation becoming "live", we requested information and examples of GDPR related materials (however big or small) from the management teams, which we collated and published on the company's intranet Platinum Info Central.

On an ongoing basis, it is important that this flow of information continues, as knowledge of the subject widens and the legislation itself evolves. The company has also attended seminars, viewed webinars, obtained advice from various credible sources and taken

numerous meetings to understand and subsequently implement GDPR practices; this is a process that continues.

As a result of these activities, we have produced a GDPR Company Policy and Best Practice, a Privacy Policy and a GDPR Master Document that encompasses all aspects of this topic including detailed data mapping and supplier information

How We Manage It

GDPR is a regular topic of Board Meetings, Management Meetings, Review Meetings and bespoke meetings convened for the sole purpose of managing aspects of GDPR.

Though GDPR is management topic ongoing, it is something that all team members should and must participate in, and contribute to. This will ensure a "group wide" approach to the security and correct use of both employee and customer data in the future.
